The **EUDN Workshop for PhD Students** aims at giving an opportunity to present papers in an informal environment, as well as to exchange the results of recent and ongoing research in different fields of development economics. In 2010, a seminar will be organized jointly by **EUDN** (<http://www.eudnet.net/>) and the *Centre d'Etudes et de Recherches sur le Développement International* (CERDI) from the University of Auvergne (<http://www.cerdi.org/>).

This seminar will take place in:

Clermont-Ferrand, France, on June 24 and 25th, 2010.

All proposals in the field of the *Development and Transition economics* are welcome. As usual for this kind of events with EUDN, presented papers will be discussed by academic discussants. In addition the participants will benefit from **key-note speeches** which might be delivered by **Prof Jean-Marie Baland** (FUNDP, University of Namur, Belgium) and **Prof Finn Tarp** (UNU-WIDER, University of Copenhagen, Denmark) on microeconomics and macroeconomics issues.

An abstract of about 250 words and a full paper, preferably in Pdf-format, should be submitted by **30 March 2010**. Both will be sent to Annie Cohade (CERDI). Acceptation with further information will be sent by **the end of April 2010**.
